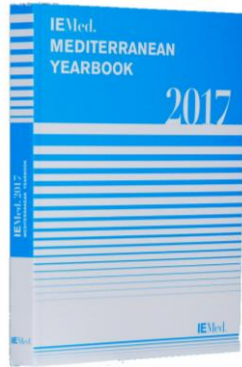


Presentation of the IEMed Mediterranean Yearbook 2017
