>> FOREWORD

The seminar is an initiative of SRM (an economic research center affiliated with Intesa Sanpaolo Group, based in Naples, and specialized in the South Italian and Mediterranean economies) together with OECD-Leed Program and Banco di Napoli. It was organized in cooperation with *The German Marshall Fund of United States* (GMF), *Istituto Affari Internazionali* (IAI), and with the support of the *Compagnia di Sanpaolo*.

The meeting will gather around **25 experts** from OECD, international financial institutions and the banking sector, to discuss the role that local and regional finance can play in fostering growth and economic development in the MENA region, especially through entrepreneurship, SMEs, and trade creation.

The seminar will start with a panel on state of play of economic relations between **Italy** and **Europe** on the one hand (at a time of stagnation and crisis in the Eurozone) and the **South Mediterranean** area on the other – which will help highlight the MENA region's growing economic importance.

The seminar will then widen the focus of discussion to include a session on the role that **finance and the banking sector** are playing in the Southern Mediterranean, with a focus on **Turkey and Morocco**, and a final session on the **potential and challenges of finance in the Gulf region**.

Speakers and participants will be expected to engage in the following questions:

- How can finance and the banking sector on both sides of the Mediterranean support cross-country entrepreneurial investment, SMEs, and trade?
- What is the present weight and size of Italian and European companies in the MENA countries? What are the main trends in business relations across the Mediterranean?
- Which MENA countries hold better prospects of supporting a dynamic domestic financial and banking sector, developed well enough to be able to operate on both sides of the Mediterranean region?
- What are the commonalities and differences in the financial and banking sectors across the MENA region?
- What is the role that private and public financial institutions play in the Gulf? What are the main lessons and experiences to be applied to the Mediterranean region?
