Selected speakers will also be invited to participate in the 2024 EU Non-Proliferation and Disarmament (EUNPD) Conference, which will take place in Brussels from 3:00 pm on 12 November to 6:00 pm on 13 November.

Candidates can be from both the EU and non-EU countries.

Travel in economy class and accommodation costs for both events will be covered, while airport and local transfers, VISA and travel insurance costs will not be borne by the conference organizers.

Age limit: 36 years old by the end of 2024.
