In 1992, he was posted to the Turkish Permanent Delegation to the European Union in Brussels where he took part in the Turkey-EU negotiations on the completion of the customs union. He is currently the chairman of the Centre for Economics and Foreign Policy Studies in Istanbul and Visiting Scholar at Carnegie Europe in Brussels.
