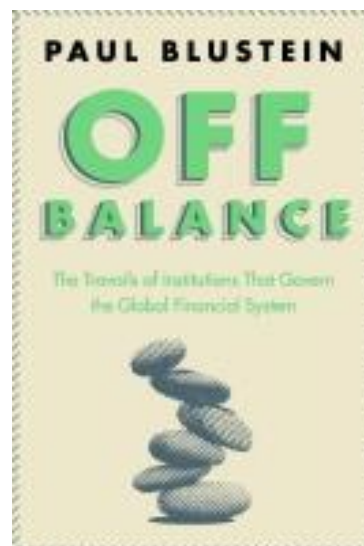

Blustein exposes serious weaknesses in these and other institutions, which lead to sobering conclusions about the governability of the global economy.
