# Italy's Perspectives on Forging a New EU-North Africa Energy Pact

The Istituto Affari Internazionali (IAI) organizes a half-day conference meant to explore the issue of the energy policies of the EU towards North Africa. The conference is part of a wider project carried out by IAI in partnership with the Enel Foundation. The project seeks to identify and evaluate concrete proposals to be introduced in the European agenda during the Italian Presidency of the EU – to improve the European initiatives towards the Southern Mediterranean in the energy domain. It aims at strengthening inter and intra-regional cooperation and fostering a sustainable and efficient energy transition in the countries of the region.

The project moves from an accurate analysis of the energy trends in North Africa in the light of important political, economic, social and demographic changes occurred in recent years, as well as from the assessment of the policies adopted by the governments of these countries to cope with the evolution of their national energy sectors.

The conference is to be held in **Rome** on **November 18, 2014**, in synergy with the Ministerial Conference on the Euro-Med energy partnership, scheduled for the following day as part of the Italian Semester of Presidency of the EU. The conference will present the preliminary results of the project, focusing in particular on the formulation and discussion of a series of recommendations and proposals for the revision of the EU energy policies towards North Africa. These proposals will be discussed by an audience of both European and Southern Mediterranean experts, representatives of public institutions and the private sector, and members of the main Euro-Mediterranean energy networks. The results of the debate will be presented in the form of final recommendations to the Italian authorities.
