

Online Winter School
CRISI UMANITARIE E CONFLITTI
21-22-23-24 November 2023 (VI Edition)

The course aims to deepen the knowledge and understanding of the role of the actors involved in peace processes and crisis management thanks to specific case studies. Furthermore, the main new analytical paradigms will be analyzed with the aim of providing the tools necessary to understand and explain the dynamics of conflict and cooperation in the legal and institutional framework at an international level.

Educational Programme

The intensive course will take place in the afternoon of 4 days (**November 21-22-23-24**) in online mode.

The course is in Italian with the possibility of some modules in English. The program is structured according to a hybrid teaching approach, which alternates seminars with debates and exercises aimed at analyzing new trends and challenges in the management of humanitarian crises and conflicts.

The teaching staff is made up of experts, researchers from the Istituto Affari Internazionali competent for the subject, and representatives of public and private institutions.

The course includes the following teaching modules:

- analysis of the various forms of violence, crises and conflicts which are currently dominant worldwide;
- the role of international organizations in conflict resolution;
- crisis analysis and management;
- protection of human rights and the role of women in conflict and post-conflict areas;
- the international debate on the new dimensions of security and fragility.

The following laboratory activities are planned:

- tools for preparing analyses, strategic reports and documents for public dissemination;
- management of situations of uncertainty and risk;
- activities for the refinement of soft skills, including time and crisis management, team working and source analysis.

For whom is this course intended?

The specialization course “Crisi Umanitarie e Conflitti” is designed to offer a thematic insight to those with a background in Social Sciences (Political Science, Economics, Law) with a specific interest in crisis management and international security.

Registration

The course is limited to a maximum of **25 attendees**. The Institute reserves the right to postpone the course if the minimum number of participants required for its launch is not reached.

In order to participate to the executive course it is necessary to fill out the online registration form, and attach your curriculum vitae.

The registration fee is **€ 449,00 (VAT included)**.

For IAI Junior Members and Lazio Youth Card holders there is a 10% **discount**. For Ministry of

Defense Employees or by submitting an **"Early Application"** to the courses that make up the Advanced Certificates of the I and II Semesters, there is the possibility of a 15% **discount** on the total fee, against immediate enrolment to be paid in a single payment.

Thanks to the contribution of the Compagnia di San Paolo Foundation, **two scholarships** are also provided to cover the entire enrollment fee, to be paid based on income and merit. At the end of the course, a certificate of participation will be delivered for those who have successfully attended at least **80% of the lessons**.
