Day 1 (Mon) 1.5 hours 1.5 hours	Lecture 1 – Introduction to Current Issues and Challenges in EU Single Market Integration (morning) Practical exercise linked to the Single Market (SM) (afternoon).
Day 2 (Tue) 1.5 hours 1.5 hours	Lecture 2 – The Effects of Brexit on EU Single Market Integration (morning) Four thematic groups meet separately (Defence SM; Digital SM; Energy SM; Finance SM) Group discussion (afternoon) led by an academic staff member from the partner universities.
Day 3 (Wed) 1.5 hours 1.5 hours	Lecture 3 – External effects of the EU single market (morning) Four thematic groups meet separately (Defence SM; Digital SM; Energy SM; Finance SM) Group discussion (afternoon) led by an academic staff member from the partner universities.
Day 4 (Thur) 1.5 hours	Research in the morning - independent work by the students in the four thematic groups. Four thematic groups meet separately (Defence SM; Digital SM; Energy SM; Finance SM) Preparing the presentations for Friday in small groups, guided by an expert.
Day 5 (Fri) 4 hours (incl. breaks) 1 hour	Presentations by the four thematic groups All summer school students attend all presentations. Concluding panel debate academics from the partner universities Cross-cutting focus to facilitate knowledge integration across the JMN VISTA thematic areas.
