## Young Women in Non-Proliferation and Disarmament Mentorship Programme

The International Affairs Institute (IAI) and the Vienna Center for Disarmament and Non-Proliferation (VCDNP) invite female undergraduate, graduate, and post-graduate students as well as recent graduates to apply to a Young Women in Non-Proliferation and Disarmament Mentorship Programme.

The mentorship programme seeks to engage young women in the field of non-proliferation, arms control and disarmament, and promote awareness about these issues.

The programme will pair successful applicants with well-known experts to establish a mentoring relationship, which envisions regular videoconferencing sessions. Participants will also be expected to attend select conferences, including a next generation workshop in Spring 2021. Networking and career opportunities will be facilitated through seminars, socials, and other activities.

The mentorship programme is open to female students currently enrolled in undergraduate, graduate, or post-graduate programmes, as well as recent graduates (graduated less than three years ago). The programme will be conducted in English; therefore, good English language skills are essential.

The deadline for applications is **26 February 2021**. Applications should be submitted in English and include:

- 1. A curriculum vitae of the applicant (maximum 2 pages)
- 2. A letter of interest of no more than 500 words
- 3. A record of courses taken to date and grades received, and
- 4. One recommendation letter.
